From Our Pastor's Desk...

These days, ice and snow blanket the landscape, and I have been reflecting on that wonderful passage of scripture from the book of Ecclesiastes - *For everything there is a season....a time to plant and a time to pluck up what is planted....* I think I'm trying to convince myself that it won't always be winter!

In spite of the fact that the temperatures are in the deep freeze, my friends who are gardeners are pouring over their seed catalogues, planning the layout of their spring plantings and checking their seed supplies. It won't be long before we start seeing seed packets in the grocery store. I even started working on a quilt that is filled with fabrics that depict fruits and vegetables in all their harvest glory.

During my prayer time one morning recently, I came across a quote from Maya Angelou that struck me as deep wisdom, and I wanted to share it. She writes, *There is an immutable life principle with which many people will quarrel. Although nature has proven season in and season out that if the thing that is planted bears at all, it will yield more of itself, there are those who seem certain that if they plant tomato seeds, at harvest time they can reap onions.* We all plant seeds - whether they are tomato seeds or the seeds of our lives - and all too often we get caught in the trap of hoping that we will reap what we have not sowed.

We join a gym, go a couple of times a month, and complain that we have not seen any results. We join the church, come occasionally, and wonder why it doesn't seem like our spiritual life is very fruitful. We complain about our spouse or our children or our parents or our friends, and we wonder why our relationships aren't fulfilling. We sign up for a class, neglect to

do our homework, and wonder why our grades aren't what we'd hoped. We plant tomatoes and we expect onions to grow!

The public outcry over the recent shooting in Tucson is like that, I think. For years our nation has resisted gun control, defending the Constitutional right to bear arms, telling ourselves that people kill people - not guns. Our public discourse incites anger and blame and a "take no prisoners" attitude. Yet we are shocked and horrified when a Congresswoman and a Judge and 17 others are shot in cold blood. I can't help but wonder, why would we expect it to be different? We have planted the seeds of violence, and we shouldn't be surprised when we reap violence that is senseless and jarring. If we want a different result, we need to plant different seeds.

The middle of winter is a perfect time to reflect on the seeds that we will plant when spring arrives. Today the snow blankets the earth, the soil is dormant, and we all have a little time to prepare. But spring will come! Our faith invites us to plant seeds of love, seeds of forgiveness, seeds of justice and peace, seeds of integrity, seeds of generosity, seeds of kindness and compassion, seeds of joy and self-giving service.

The life of faith is like every other garden. Some of those seeds won't grow - and we may never know why. But others will germinate and take root and grow strong and healthy. They will bear fruit when the season is ripe. When you are planning your garden, you have to begin with the end in mind! If you want tomatoes, you've got to plant tomatoes! Now is the time to start!

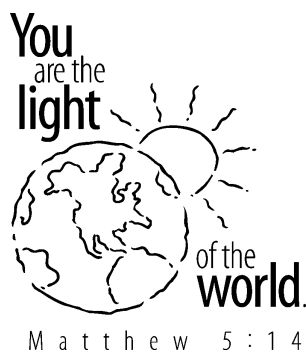


