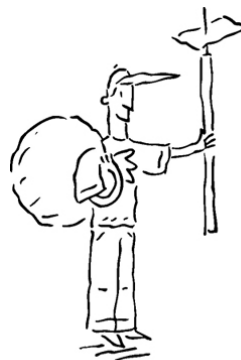
Elder Law and Elder Abuse Forum

Haitian Life Now

Silentor Esthil-Henderson will give a presentation regarding his life and experiences in Haiti on **May 22 at 11:30 am** in Baxter Fellowship Hall. These are some quotes from him: *"Ever since the earthquake in Haiti, things have been quite difficult. My father (Tommy Henderson) has shared with me that he has been attending your church. I am happy to hear this. If it was not for Tommy Henderson's call to serve the poor of Haiti none of this would be happening."*

Silentor Esthil-Henderson was born in Haiti and blessed to have had the opportunity to come to the United States at the age of nine. After living in the United States for 13 years and participating in programs such as the YMCA and Boys and Girls Club, he wishes to provide similar programs for educational purposes to encourage and inspire life-long development for the families and children of rural areas in Haiti. In that effort, Silentor started the LaCroix Afterschool Program (LAP) in partnership with another organization called LaCroix Haiti New Testament mission that has been in the community for 25 years. LAP programs are designed to meet children's needs for safe, enjoyable and productive activity during non-school hours. *"I have decided to return to Haiti full-time this coming June to run a Youth ministry. My pastor in Haiti has 3500 children in his schools and was praying for someone to work with them. I am called to return and serve the children in Haiti. God has a plan for me in Haiti and I will follow his plans."*

Birdies for Charity!

Enclosed with this newsletter is the 2011 pledge form for the Birdies for Charities drive. Even though this drive is connected with the John Deere Golf Classic, all monies raised by Edwards will go to Edwards. Any additional charity money raised during the golf tournament will go into a big pot that is shared by all charities. So the money sent back to Edwards will be more than pledged, which is guaranteed to be at least five percent. In years past Edwards has used the money to help buy the new choir robes, music stands for the bell choir, and several maintenance items for the church.

For those of you not familiar with golf, a birdie is when the player completes a hole using at least one stroke less than standard, (par). For reference, if 1800 birdies are made during the tournament, a pledge of \$.01 per birdie would have resulted in a commitment of \$18.00.

All pledges must be in to the tournament officials by July 8. You may mail it directly to the address on the back of the pamphlet, or return it to Kathy Bowerman at the church, no later than Sunday, July 3rd. We will insure all pledges are submitted in time.

All entries are automatically entered in the Birdies contest. If you guess the exact number of birdies made during the tournament, you may win a new 2011 Chevy Camaro automobile. In case of ties, a drawing will determine the winner of the car. Other prizes include a riding mower and car washes. If no one guesses the exact number of birdies, the closest guess will win, but the car will be given away.

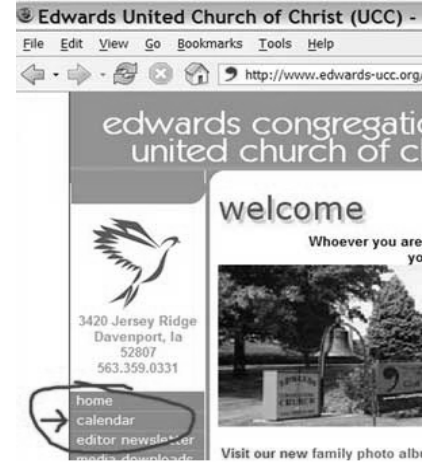
