

## *From Our Pastor's Desk...*

---

**E**very year, it seems as though the summer flies by faster than ever, and this year is no exception! Here it is August, and kids are getting ready to go back to school, vacations are a thing of the past, and at the church we're gearing up for fall!

This month (the 12<sup>th</sup> to be exact), we will welcome Rev. Kendra Thompson, our new Minister of Faith Formation, into the fold at Edwards. Kendra is a graduate of Austin Theological Seminary in Austin, Texas (a classmate of Crystal McCormick!), and is an ordained minister in the Christian Church (Disciples of Christ) - a sister denomination to the UCC. Kendra and her husband, John, are moving to the Quad Cities from Kansas, where John has just completed his PhD in Social Work at the University of Kansas in Lawrence. He will be joining the faculty at St. Ambrose this month.

Welcoming someone new onto our staff is an important practice of faith for us all - hospitality has always been a core value in Christian faith. So, it's worth thinking a bit about how each one of us can be part of the welcoming committee. Here's some ideas:

**Wear your nametag for the next year! Every Sunday!** You may think that you've been around long enough for everyone to know your name, but Kendra doesn't know ANY names! (and neither do any of our many visitors) Help her get to know you, and don't expect that she will be able to remember everyone's names right at first.

**Sign up for one of the welcoming gatherings that will be held during August!** The best way to get to know someone is in a small group setting. Sign up for one of the welcoming coffees so that she can get to know you personally - and so that you can get to know her. Share your dreams and help her to craft new programs!

**Don't assume that just because you don't have children in the education wing that you don't need to get to know her (or that she doesn't need to know you)!** Intergenerational opportunities are an important part of faith formation at Edwards. Kendra needs to get to know us all, as she begins the work of shaping Christian Education for all ages in our church. Make it easy for her!

**Volunteer to help in the education program before Kendra asks for help!** One of the most difficult things to do when you are new in a community is to ASK for help. Make this easy. Offer your gifts. Tell her about the things you really like doing for Christian Education programming. Tell her what you would be willing to do...in a pinch. Ministry is a partnership - let's do our part to make it one!

**Never start a sentence with "*Susan used to...*"** Kendra is Kendra - not Susan. Whether we know it or not, each one of us is a part of the "official welcoming committee"! Let's make sure we show Kendra what a wonderful congregation Edwards really is - from the very beginning!




**Get Ready...to WORK!**

### Transition, Transition!

With the announcement that Katherine will be retiring in June of 2013, a whole new set of transitions is beginning. The first step in our journey toward calling Edwards' next pastor is to FORM A SEARCH COMMITTEE!

In our Bylaws, the Church Council is responsible for gathering the Search Committee, and they are spending this month working to put together a list of names. If you know someone you think would be a good Search Committee member, please make sure that our Moderator, Shirley Johnson, knows.

Once the Search Committee is formed, they will be officially dedicated - hopefully at our Building Dedication Service on September 9<sup>th</sup>.

Next, we will assemble a "church profile", a detailed description of Edwards Church, which will be distributed to UCC pastors who are searching for a call. When we start receiving ministerial profiles, the Search Committee will read profiles, interview candidates, and finally choose a candidate to be presented to the congregation for approval.

The process should take about a year. When it is time for Katherine to retire, we should be close to calling our next pastor. We will probably need a "transitional" minister for a few months, as we make the final shift from Katherine's 15 year pastorate to our new pastor. Stay tuned for new information as it becomes available!

### More Staff Changes!

This month we will be saying good-bye to Miriam Prichard, who has been our Youth Director for the past year. Miriam will continue to sit in the pews and participate in the life and ministry of our congregation - just not as part of our staff.

We will "officially" say good-bye to her in worship this month, but (at her request) we will not be hosting a reception! Send a card, write an email, make a phone call... However you do it, make sure to extend your thanks and appreciation to Miriam for her work with our youth!

We are in the process of filling that position, and if you have ideas, please pass those on to Tom Kenneke, chair of the Personnel Board.

## Landscaping Plan

The Building Task Force has asked **Sandy Doran**, a member of Edwards' congregation and a professional landscape architect, to prepare a comprehensive church grounds landscaping plan and an implementation explanation. The plan, which highlights the order of priority of the various areas to be landscaped, is posted at <http://www.edwards-ucc.org/library/> and will be on display in Baxter Hall. George Kovacs has volunteered to be the contact person for the comprehensive landscape plan implementation. From mid-July to mid-August/September the landscape work will center around amending the soil with compost in preparation for mid-August/September grass seeding.
